

Top 10 COOL Things for Families To Do ON HILTON HEAD ISLAND

1. Kayak

Kayak is easy and you will love being on the waters edge. All the marinas offer tours

2. Beach Walk

You can walk the entire beach of Hilton Head Island. Be sure to bring extra sun block and water or stop by one of the oceanfront resorts for lunch and a cold drink. The length is approximately 12 miles.

3. Historical Tour

Do it yourself or hire a guide. Hilton Head is centered in the middle of some Historical cities including Savannah, Charleston and Beaufort.

4. Bikes

Nothing more fun than renting some beach cruisers and heading out on the town's bike pathways or beach.

5. Real Estate

Take a day off out of the sun! Either self guided or with one of our associates tour our "Star Properties" noted on the map. (Some gated communities require an associate)

6. Fireworks

The fireworks are fun in Shelter Cove Harbour June - August. Fireworks are the main event for HarbourFest every Tuesday evening along with arts and crafts with a special fireworks show on July 4th. As always, all events at Shelter Cove Harbour are free and open to the public.

7. Museum

Go visit the Coastal Discovery Museum and sign up for one of several events like the Turtle Talk and Walk... An evening lecture and beach walk to educate participants about the threatened Loggerhead sea turtle.

8. Lighthouse

How many steps to the top of the Lighthouse? You may want to combine your trip to the famed Harbour Town to be later afternoon and enjoy a concert by Gregg Russell under the Old Oak (starts before dark), then dinner and the lighthouse!

9. Shop

Great shopping sites included Shelter Cove, Sea Pines, Wexford, and Coligny Circle. If you go off Island be sure to head to the outlets before 4 pm in the afternoon to avoid rush hour. Rainy days can be busy at the outlets!

10. Daufuskie

Flip this map over and you have a day trip to Daufuskie with the top ten things to do including local artist!

Top 10 COOL Things for Families To Do ON DAUFUSKIE ISLAND

1. Freeport Marina

Rent a golf cart. Also visit the real estate office for a special tour and talk if you want to find you about the real estate offerings and enjoy a tour while you see some great property including the brand new Daufuskie Bluff and Gullah Place.

2. Beach Time

The land to the right is Savannah's Tybee Island and to the left is Harbourtown in Sea Pines. Park your cart as they are not allowed on the beach.

3. Silver Dew Pottery

Stop in and see Lancy and Emily Burn. They sell pottery that they make, plus display locally found Indian stone tools and pottery shards dating back thousands of years.

4. The Iron Fish

Stop in and meet artist Chase Allen and see his timeless works of art and steel. This outdoor gallery is displayed on his porch and in his garden.

5. Daufuskie Art Gallery

Works and display from more than 14 different artists, most of them living on Daufuskie can be seen here.



6. Visit a Model @ Gullah Place

This new community offers cottage style homes completely turn key and ready starting in the low \$300's. A salesperson hosts this furnished model daily and has real estate information for the best buys on Daufuskie Island including Daufuskie Bluff.

7. Marshside Mamas

A local favorite for dinner.. a feeling of the Bahamas on Daufuskie (open for lunch sometimes). This is also the public dock for Daufuskie Island.

8. Visit the Stables

A fun time to play some horse shoes and say hello to the horses (be careful as some bite) and just enjoy the setting.

9. Visit the Mansion

Maybe you want to come back and stay or play golf... walk in take a look around and walk out the back door to enjoy the views.

10. Hit the Beach Club
